Jacksonville Watercolor Society (JWS)

JWS invites members to enter their paintings in the 2018 Members Summer Show which will be exhibited at Anthem Lakes Rotunda Gallery from June 10 through August 30. Here are some of the changes from our juried shows:

- You must be a member in good standing (2018 dues must be paid by the end of March).
- Members may enter up to three paintings per artist (no entry fees).
- Photos of paintings and entry forms must be submitted by email by April 27.
- Actual paintings will be received on May 21 at Anthem Lakes.
- JWS show standards have been relaxed for this show only. Please review minimal standards which are still required for paintings to be accepted at receiving.
- Paintings with nudity, political or religious subjects will not be accepted, as requested by Anthem Lakes.
- This is not a juried show. In the event there are too many paintings to hang in the exhibit area, the director of the gallery will make the final decision regarding which paintings will be exhibited.
- People's Choice awards are planned for the opening reception to encourage all members to enter.

JWS is taking this opportunity to introduce our members to some of the processes that other organizations use for their juried shows in a non-juried learning environment. We would like to use digital images (photos) for judging in future juried shows. There are three contacts available to answer your questions and guide you, if necessary (see summary). Last minute assistance will also be available at the April 24th Monthly meeting.

Please send photos as soon as possible to make sure your paintings will be entered.

Step 1. PHOTO OF PAINTING—Determine which paintings to submit and take a photo of each painting with a camera (or phone).

Step 2. PHOTO OF ENTRY FORM - Complete and sign the entry form for each painting. Make additional copies, if needed for multiple entries. Take a photo of each completed entry form with a camera or scan.

Step 3. EMAIL PHOTOS—Attach the photo of your painting and the image of the entry form to an email and send to **JWS.shows@gmail.com** on or before April 27. Please include your name and title of painting in the subject, one email for each painting. Any emails received after April 27 will not be accepted in the show. Start sending your photos(s) now!

Step 4. FRAME PAINTING—Check mat and frame and plexiglass to ensure they are in compliance with minimal framing standards and securely tape the original entry form to the back of your painting. Make sure the information on the entry form is the same as previously sent by email.

Step 5. DELIVER PAINTING—Take-in at Anthem Lakes from 12:00 -4:00 pm on May 21. There will be no drop-off points for this show. Please make personal arrangements, if you are unable to be there at this time. Actual paintings will be inspected for compliance with minimal standards and matched to email information submitted. Unaccepted paintings will be returned to artists unhung.

Step 6. OPENING RECEPTION — on June 10 from 2:00 to 4:00 pm and enjoy the show with fellow artists. Cast your vote in People's Choice awards.

Step 7. PICK UP PAINTING— at Anthem Lakes from 12:00 to 4:00 pm on August 30. Again, please make personal arrangements, if you are unable to be there at this time.

JWS 2018 Summer Show Rules

All entries must comply with the JWS minimal standards for this Summer Show below.

- Must be the original concept and work of the submitting artist, may not be a copy of other artists' work or based on photographs that are not the right and legal property of the entrant.
- Cannot have been worked on in a workshop or classroom situation.
- Must be executed in an aqueous manner on paper or Yupo. No collage, impasto, or other mixed media accepted. No prints or Giclees accepted .
- Water-soluble media: watercolor, acrylic in an aqueous manner, gouache, egg tempura, and casein are permitted.
- Oils of any kind, use of newsprint, magazine material or computer-generated material are not acceptable.
- Paintings shall be unvarnished. Any diptych, triptych or other multiple works shall be mounted in a single frame.
- Accepted paintings cannot be removed under any circumstances until the end of the show.

Minimal Framing Standards

- Art work not suitably or safely mounted is unacceptable.
- Acrylic plastic (plexiglass) is required on all entries. No glass!
- All colors and types of frames up to 2" in width with no embellishments will be accepted. No restrictions on the sizes of the frames or on the mats or colored filets for this show only. Exhibit space may limit the number of large paintings over 40+".
- Wire shall be securely fastened to conventional flat holders. No screw eye or saw tooth hangers will be accepted.
- Frame, mat and plexiglass should be free of dirt and scratches.
